Where do I park to attend the Mid Am at Kinloch?

Parking is free and available at the Capital One parking garage on Tuckahoe Parkway from Thursday, September 19th, through Monday, September 23rd. There are several entrances to the Capital One complex. Enter campus from **Tuckahoe Creek Parkway**, not from West Creek Parkway or Capital One Drive."



Please follow the directions signs to enter the Capital One complex on Tuckahoe Creek Parkway. Kinloch will announce when parking becomes available for public use. Until then, all parking is at Capital One. Please note: Capital One is a secure facility. There are no facilities available other than the parking garage.

How do I get from Capital One to Kinloch?

James Limousine will provide a complimentary shuttle service from the Capital One parking garage to the main entrance gate on the corner of Kinloch Road and Kinloch Lane and back to the Capital One Parking Complex. These shuttles will depart every 15 minutes.

When do the gates open?

The golf course can be accessed beginning at 7:00 AM.

Can I bring my phone or camera to the Mid-Am Championship?

Yes, but please be mindful of our Mobile Device requirements:

- Devices must always be silent; flash may not be used.
- Devices may be used to capture video, audio, and photos in all areas throughout the championship week.
- Content may be used for personal purposes (e.g., personal social media); no commercial use.
- No live streaming or real-time coverage (e.g., no shot-by-shot coverage).
- Data use (e.g., texting) is permitted in all areas throughout Tournament week.
- Phone calls are allowed only in areas away from play.
- Please respect play and do not interfere with players, caddies or media.
- All posted signage and instructions from Championship staff must be observed.
- Failure to comply with this policy may result in revocation of your ticket.

Where can I eat at the Championship?

On the Course.

There will be two on-course locations, one at the 4th tee for light pick-up snacks and beverages and one at the 15th for light food, snacks, and beverages. Kinloch is a cashless club. All sales will be by credit card only.

In the Clubhouse:

Dining will be available in the clubhouse. Breakfast and lunch will be offered on the following schedule:

- Breakfast 7:00 AM until 11:00 AM
- Lunch 11:00 AM until 3:00 PM

A tent overlooking the 18th green will have additional seating and beverage service. Kinloch is a cashless club. All sales will be by credit card only.

May I bring my own food and drinks to the course?

No, outside food and drinks are not permitted.

Can I bring a folding chair or stroller?

Folding chairs and strollers that can collapse to carry into a car are permitted.

I cannot walk the entire golf course. Will I be able to attend?

Mobility scooters are available at no charge for spectators needing them. Please inquire at the Golf Shop.

Can I buy Championship and Club logoed merchandise?

The Golf Shop at Kinloch and Independence will be open to the general public. Again, Kinloch is a cashless club. All sales will be by credit card only.

What if I lose something? Where can I inquire if it has been found?

All lost items will be turned into the Golf Shop and logged for the day, time, and location where they were found. Please check with the golf shop.

What if it rains?

The championship will be played rain or shine. In the event of heavy rain, play may be suspended. In the event of suspension during play, only players, caddies, scorers, standard bearers, and USGA officials will be evacuated using strategically placed vans.

What if there is severe weather, including lightning?

The USGA intends to notify fans and volunteers in advance, if possible, of approaching inclement weather. Since providing shelter for hundreds of fans over hundreds of acres is impractical, the USGA will use a system whereby "Weather Warning" signs will be hung at all status boards when inclement weather is detected within a potentially dangerous range. Everyone else should seek shelter immediately.

Scout out the locations for shelter on the golf course before heading out on the course. Know where to go beforehand because time could be of the essence in finding a safe place. If you are caught on the course and there is no shelter nearby, consider the following tips:

- Do not stand under tall trees or sit in a golf cart.
- Do not stand under a lone tree, even a small one.
- You should not stand near a golf cart.
- Stay away from water.
- Do not wear spiked shoes; we suggest sneakers.
- Do not raise your umbrella
- If stranded in the open, go to a low place such as a ravine or valley or the lowest spot.
- The clubhouse may not be available based on building capacities.
